- (3) This is the fee to re-register a current valid certificate in your name when you purchase a boat.
Applications (New application, revalidation, amendment, trial, re-registration) requiring guaranteed 5 working day turnaround may incur an Expedited Processing Fee (EPF). Application of this fee is at the discretion of the Rating Office and owners will be advised in advance of the charge being levied.
- (4) The short-handed certificate fee only applies where the boat already holds a primary IRC certificate. See Rule 9.2.1.
